

Quality: Golf course grass seed...

Our seed is selected from one of the oldest and largest seed stockists and blenders in northern England. Here, grass seed is sourced from Europe's top breeders to provide mixtures suitable for the UK climate.

In addition, varieties are selected for their excellent characteristics whether that is drought tolerance, colour, recovery etc. **All are STRI (Sports Turf Research Institute) rated.**

No weed seeds...

All seed requires compulsory Certification through the EEC for **germination** and **purity**. Our seed is the highest rated and has therefore achieved the additional HVS (Higher Voluntary Standard) Certification.

Rye Grass is a good option...

Rye grass can be coarse, however, ours is a specially selected dwarf amenity grass with an excellent emerald colour. We use it in some of our mixtures as it enhances the look and improves the durability of a lawn.

It's Fresh and it will Keep...

Our seed is bagged as soon as possible after harvesting to ensure purity, low moisture content and longevity. Customers storing unused seed in a cool, dark, dry area will have satisfactory germination at least 3 years after date of bagging.

How much...

See **COVERAGE** at the bottom of the page for each grass variety in our shop. Always order 20% more than needed to accommodate errors in spreading and or measuring. More may be required if bird attack is anticipated. It is also a good idea to have a quantity (20% or more) for patching and repairs later on.
