**Assembly:**

Assemble the aerator following the diagram shown overleaf.

When connecting the spike wheels, ensure the spikes are positioned in alternate rows for maximum aeration.

When assembling the handle, protect the top of the handle with a block of wood and use a mallet or similar to ensure that the three sections are firmly interconnected, before fixing with the bolts (Q).

Nuts (O) are nylon lock nuts. To use these effectively, tighten the nut until the thread of spike (P) protrudes through the nylon insert and then continue to tighten until fully secured. These nuts are designed not to come loose, and should not be re-used. See our website for video instructions on how to tighten the nuts :

**Operation:**

Always push the aerator in front of you.

Best results are achieved when the lawn is damp, but if used in dry conditions, effective aeration can be achieved - you just have to push harder!

**Maintenance:**

Clean the spikes and rollers thoroughly after use.

Ensure the screws are tight and handle is fast before every use.

**Safety:**

This aerator is a tool and has sharp components. DO NOT allow children to play with the aerator and store safely out of reach when not in use.

When carrying the aerator, it is advisable to hold the lowest section of the handle.
